# **Parent Survey Summary**

# Survey Respondent Profile



- One thousand and sixteen (1,016) parents responded to the CBE Parent/Guardian Survey.
- The total CBE school enrollment for the 2016-2017 year was two thousand six hundred and seventy-eight (2,678) students. The total enrollment data was used as a guide to estimate the total number of parents.
- One thousand and sixteen (1,016) is a good representative sample of CBE parents.

# Survey Respondent Profile



- In terms of respondent demographics, the majority of CBE parent survey respondents were female, seventy-nine percent (79%).
- There was no difference in responses between male and female respondents.

# Survey Respondent Profile



- 72% of respondents were non- Catholic and 28% were Catholic.
- Most of the respondents, 55%, have children in grades 1 through 5.
- In terms of the gender of the children of the survey respondents, 54% of respondents have male children and 56% have female children.
- The majority of respondents have children who have attended the school for a period of one to three years.
- None of the aforementioned factors had any impact on the responses of the parent.

# Survey Respondent Profile



- Thirteen percent (13%) of respondents have children who previously graduated from their child's current school.
- Sixty-four percent (64%) of these persons said that their child had been well prepared for the next stage in their life; thirty-five percent (35%) responded that their child had been prepared fairly well.

# Survey Respondent Profile



Thirteen percent (13%) of respondents have children who previously graduated from their child's current school. Sixty-four percent (64%) of these persons said that their child had been well prepared for the next stage in their life; thirty-five percent (35%) responded that their child had been prepared fairly well.

The main reason respondents sent their child/children to a CBE school was overwhelmingly, seventy-six percent (76%) of CBE parents/guardians, because of the academic excellence of the school.

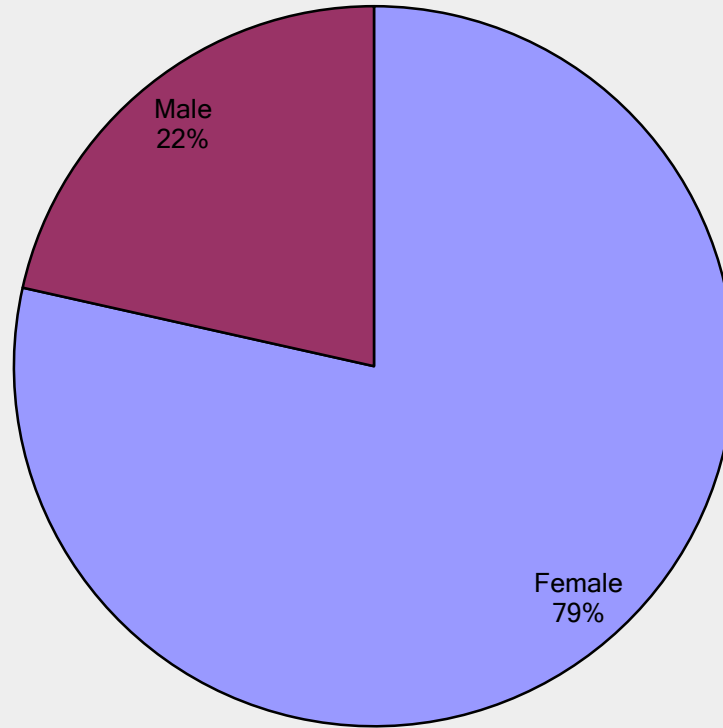

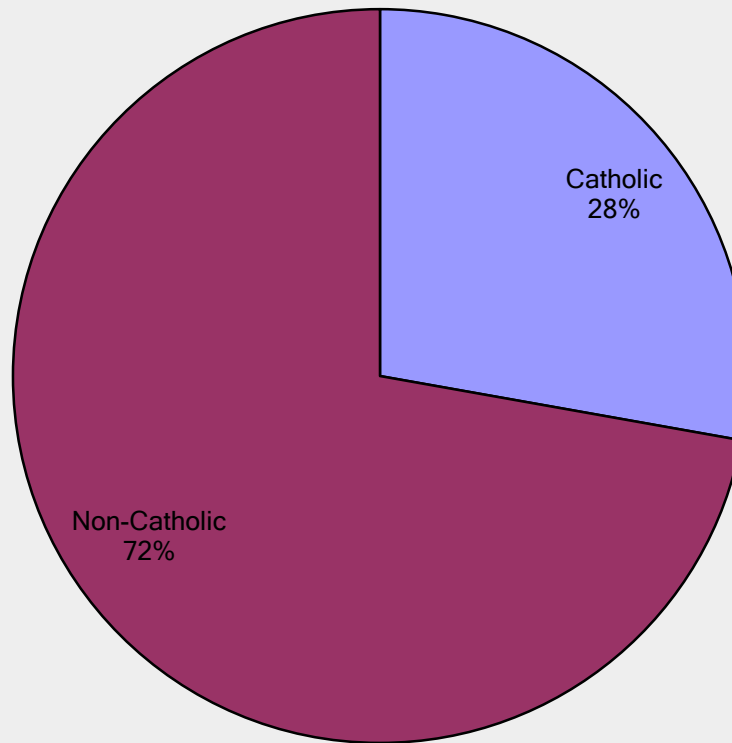
What is your gender?

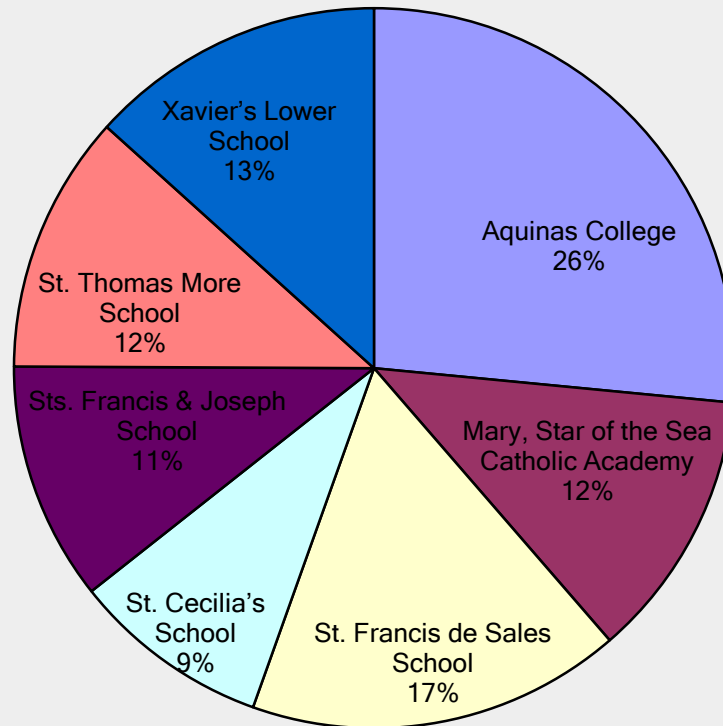
What is your current religion?

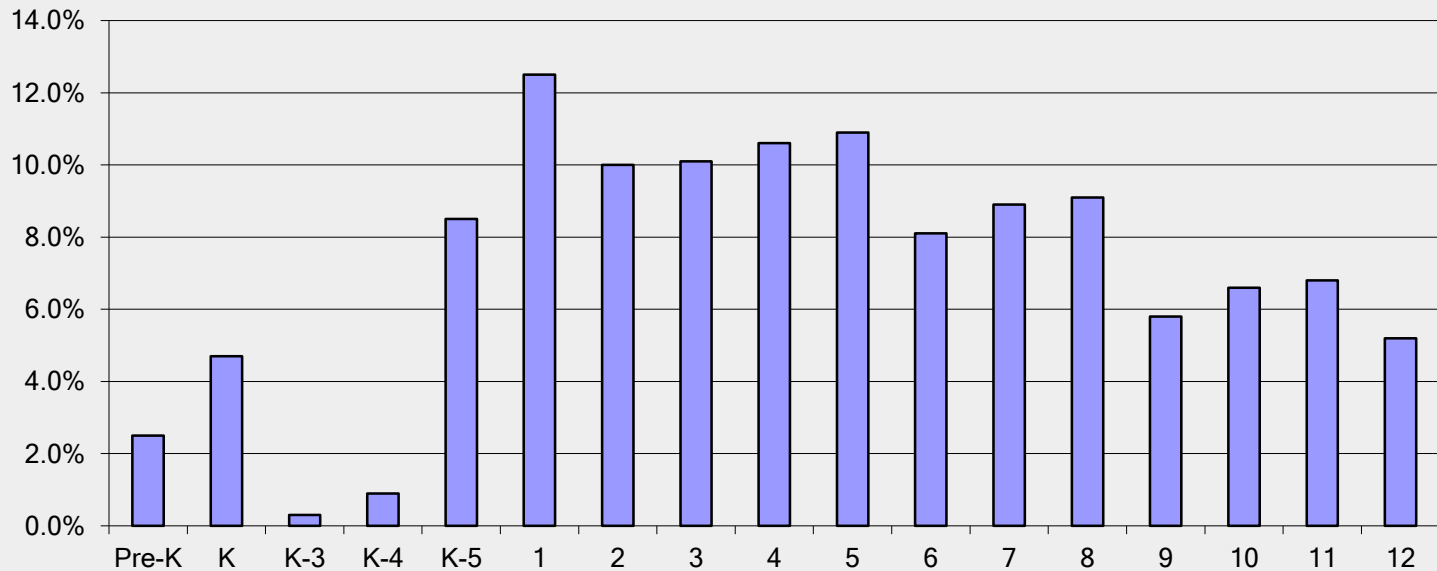
What school does your child attend?

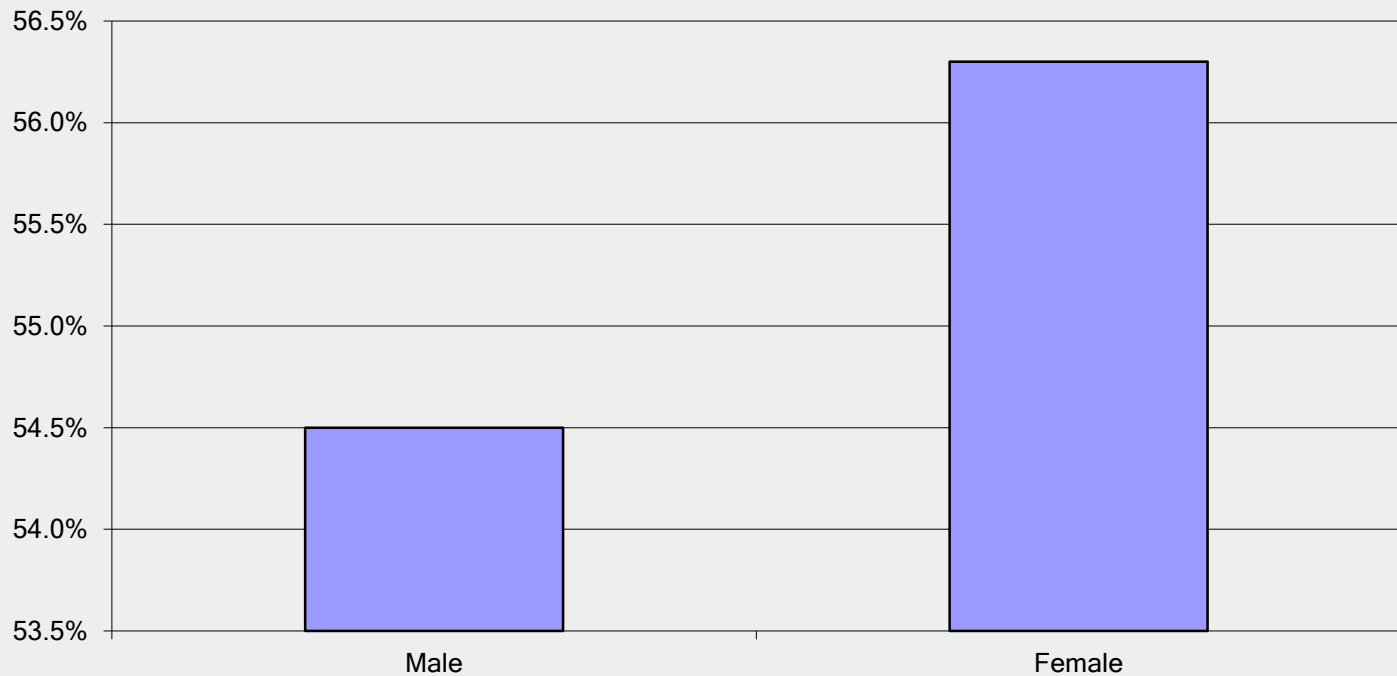

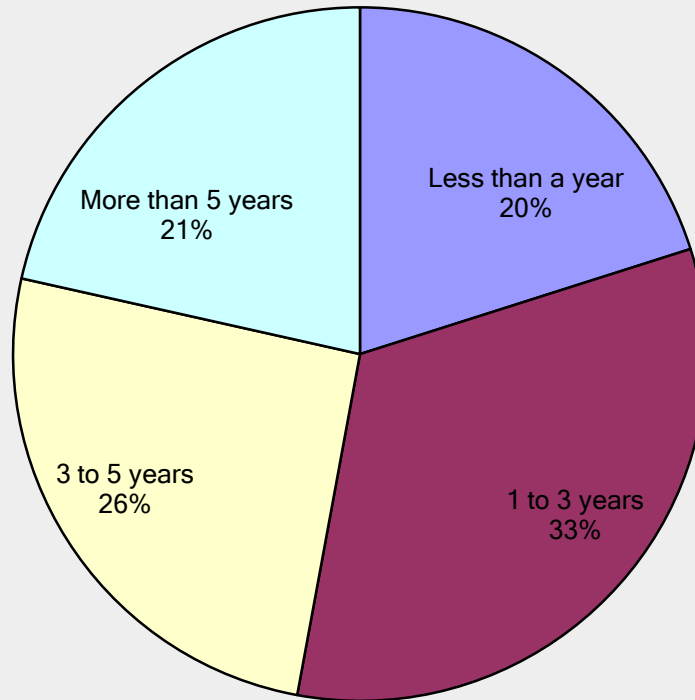

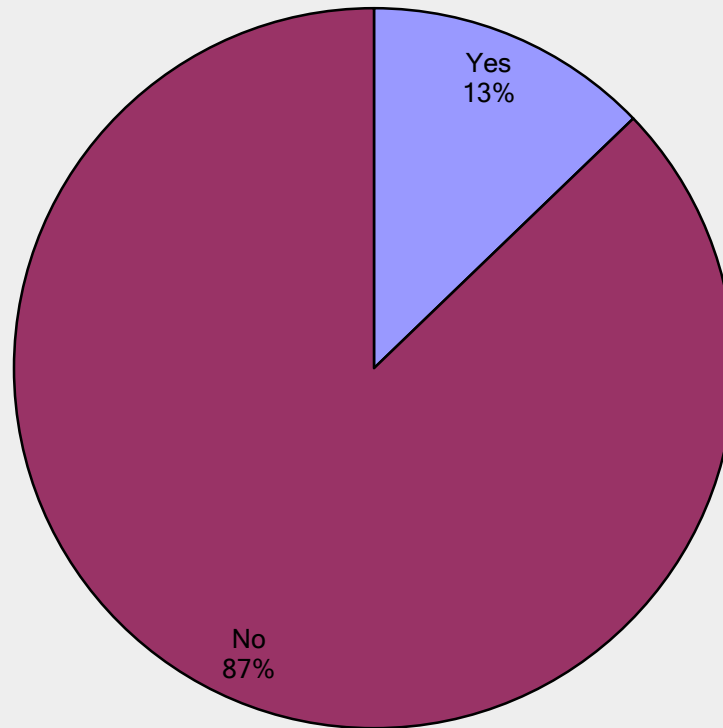

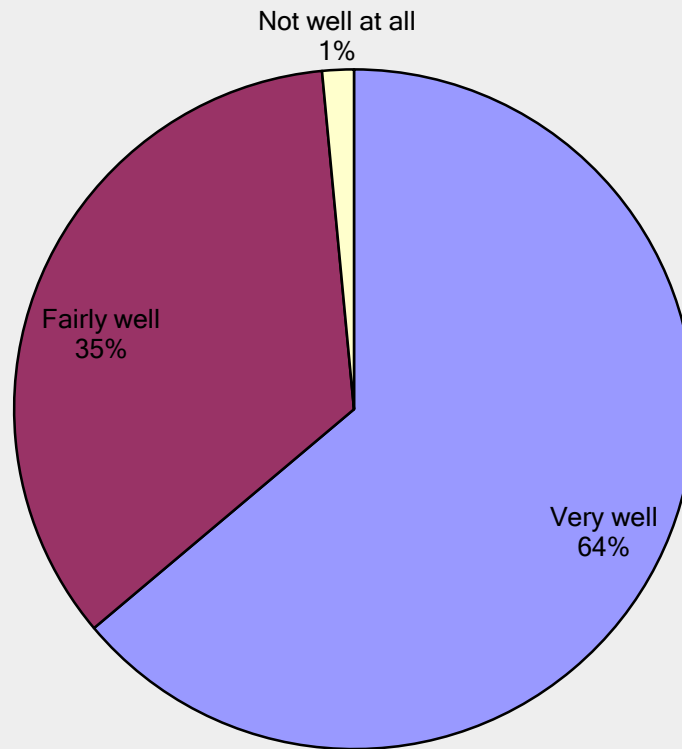

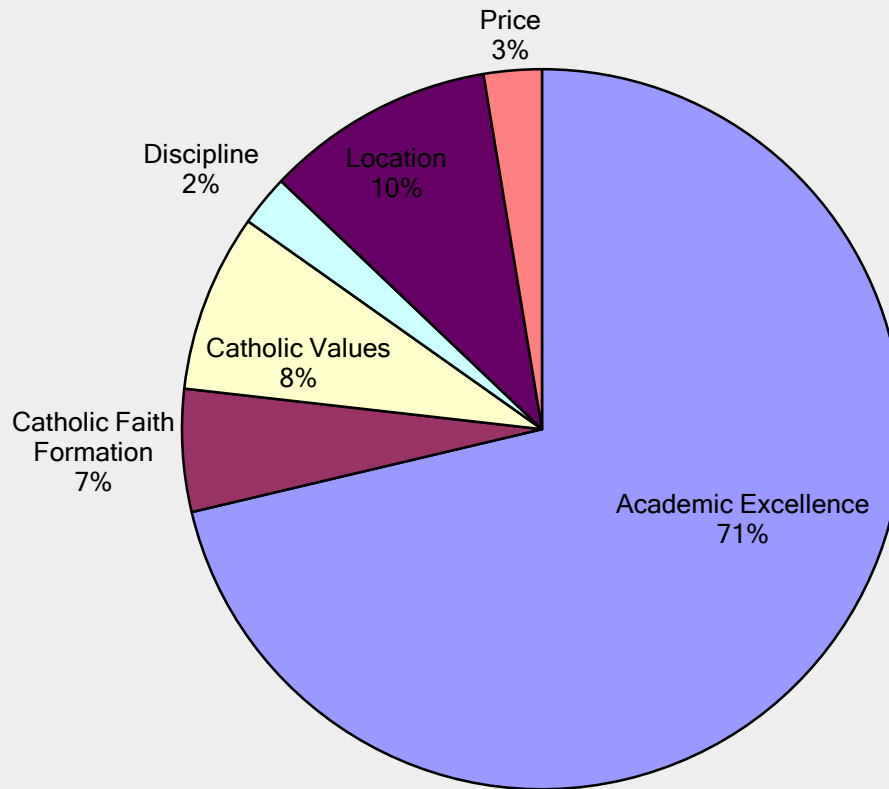

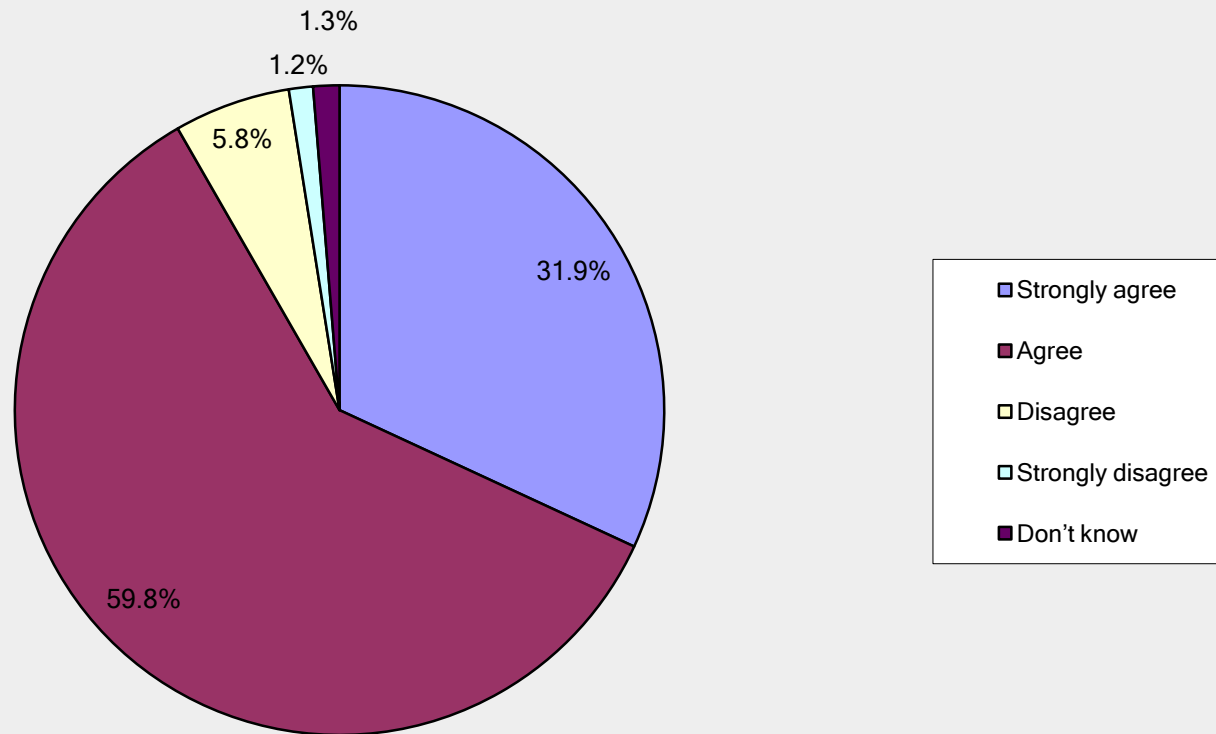

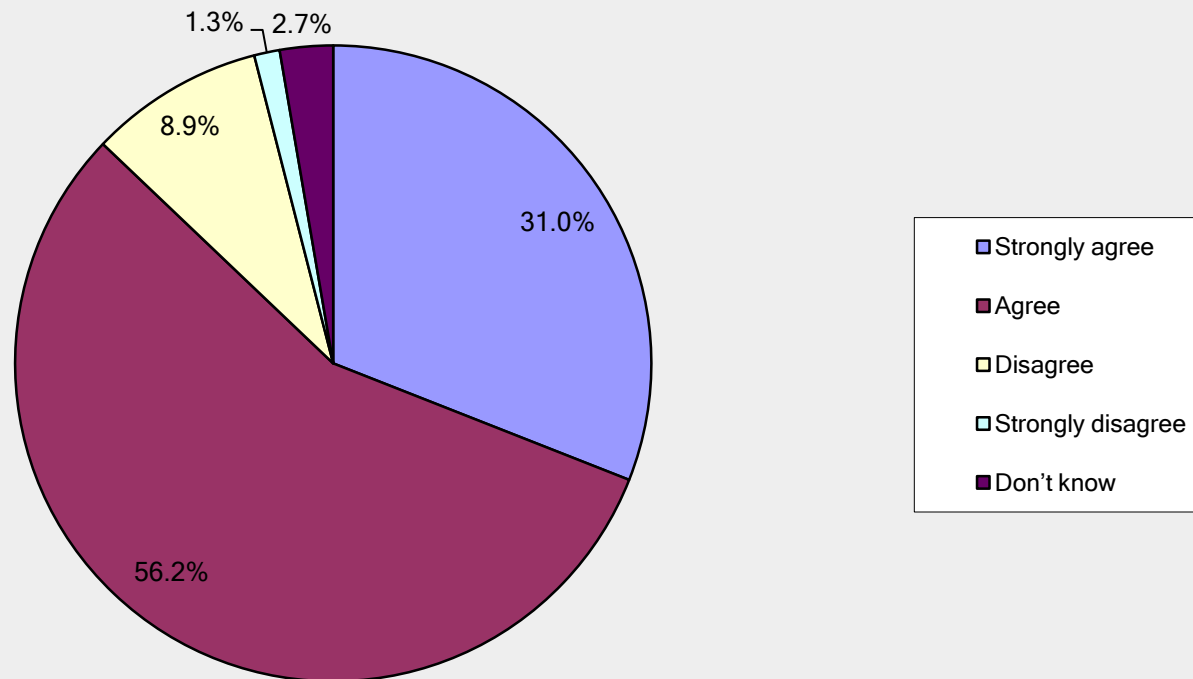

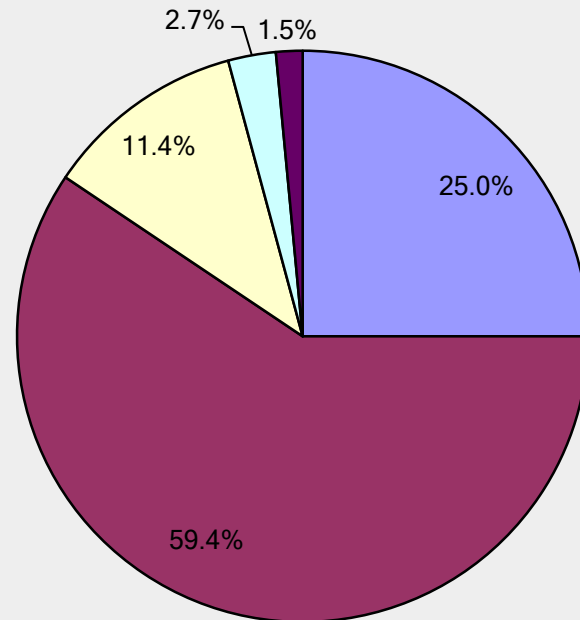

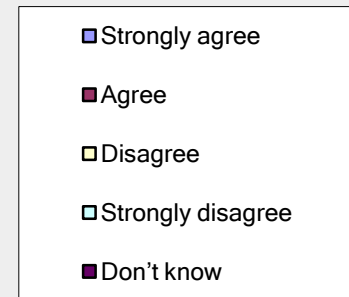
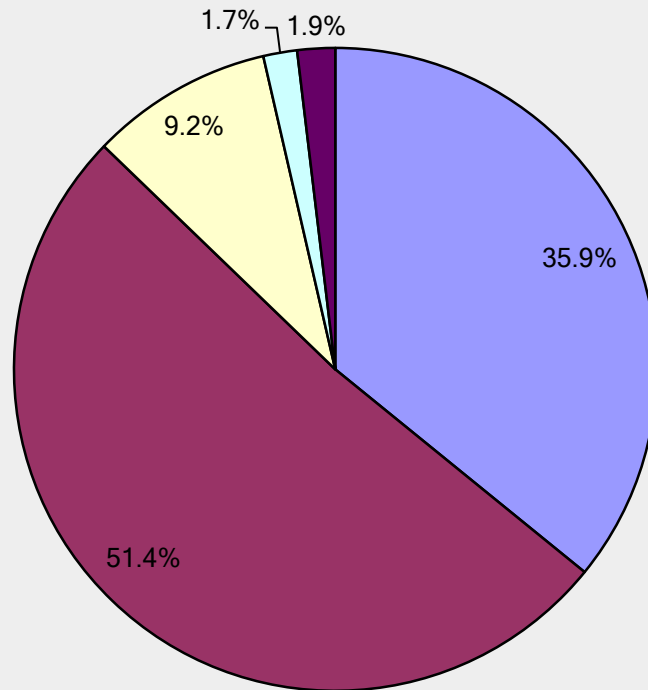


- The majority of respondents agreed with the statements relative to the subject of Administrators & Teachers.

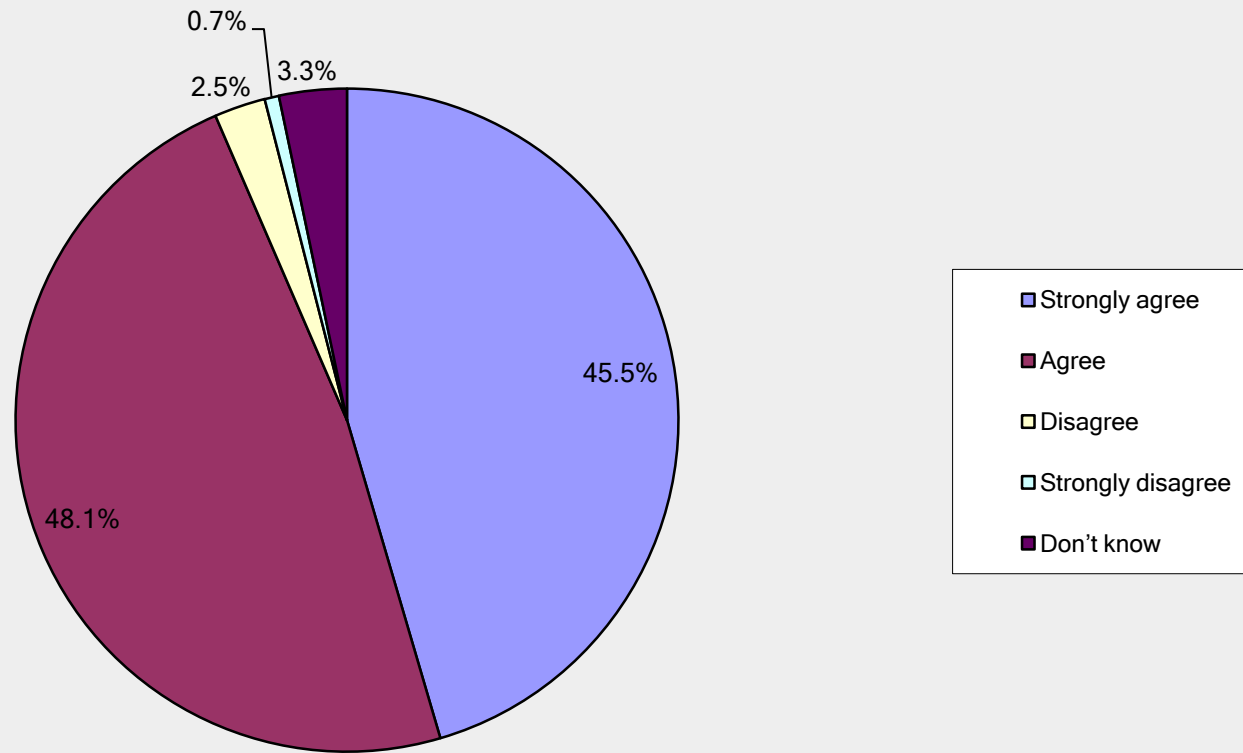

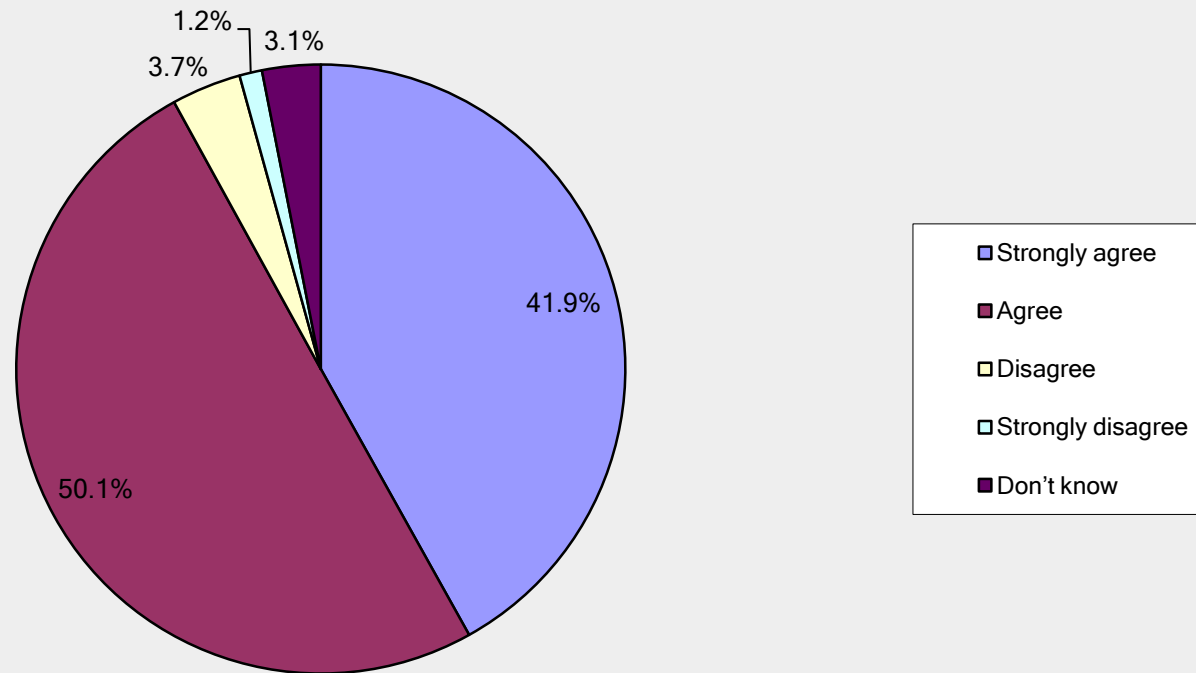

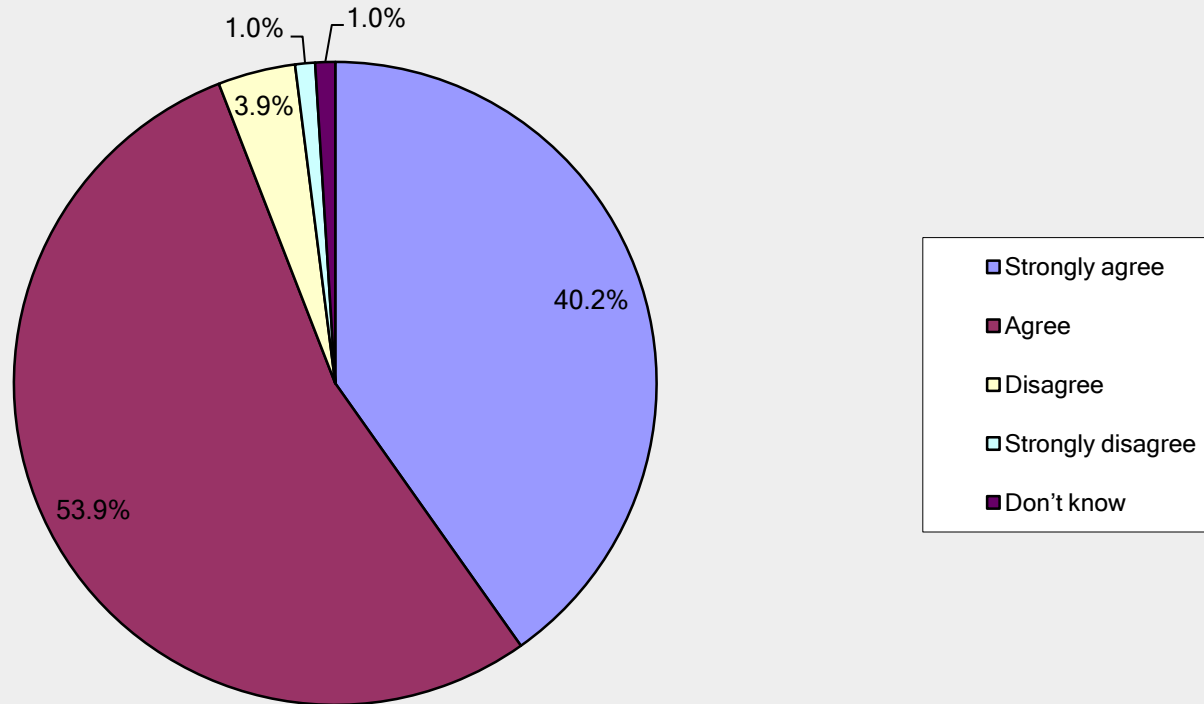


- The majority of respondents agree that the facilities of CBE schools are of acceptable standards.

# Summary

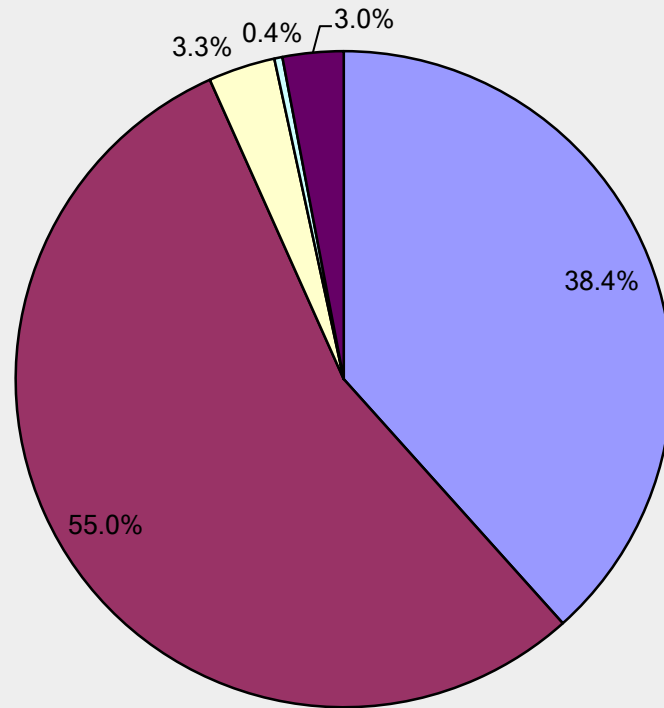


- The majority of respondents agreed with the positive statements relative to school values.

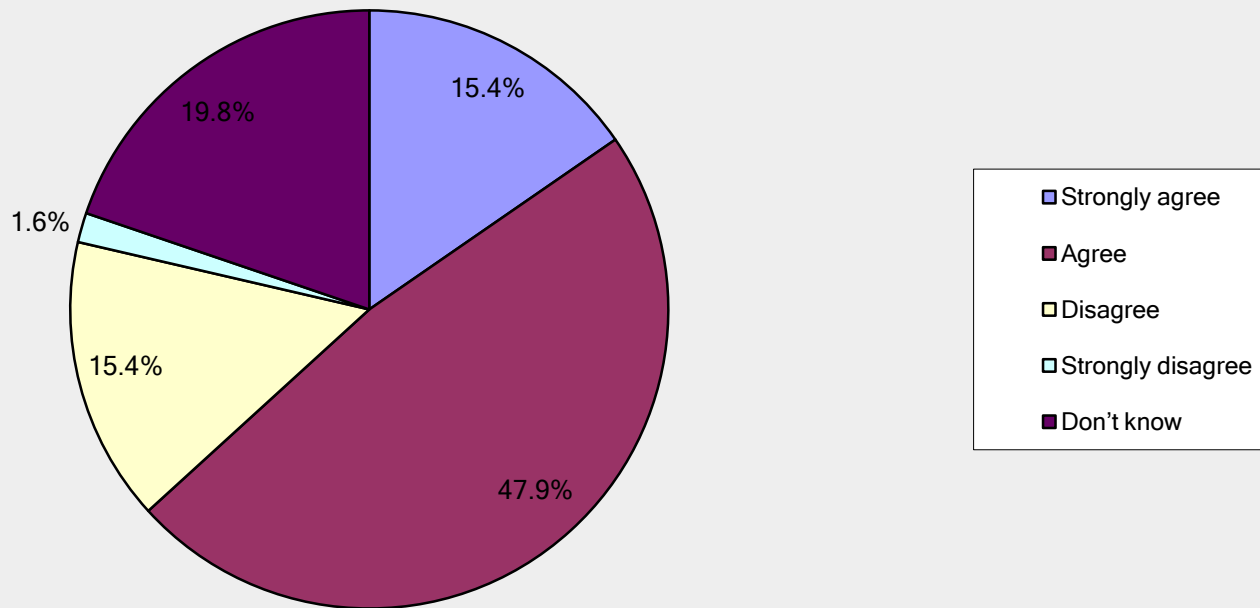

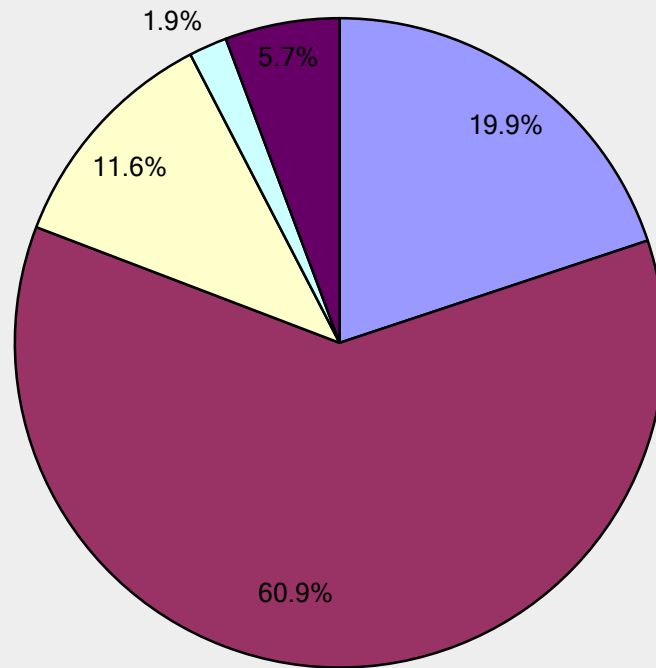


- The majority of respondents feel that there are sufficient extracurricular activities available at their school and that the majority of parents support extracurricular activities.

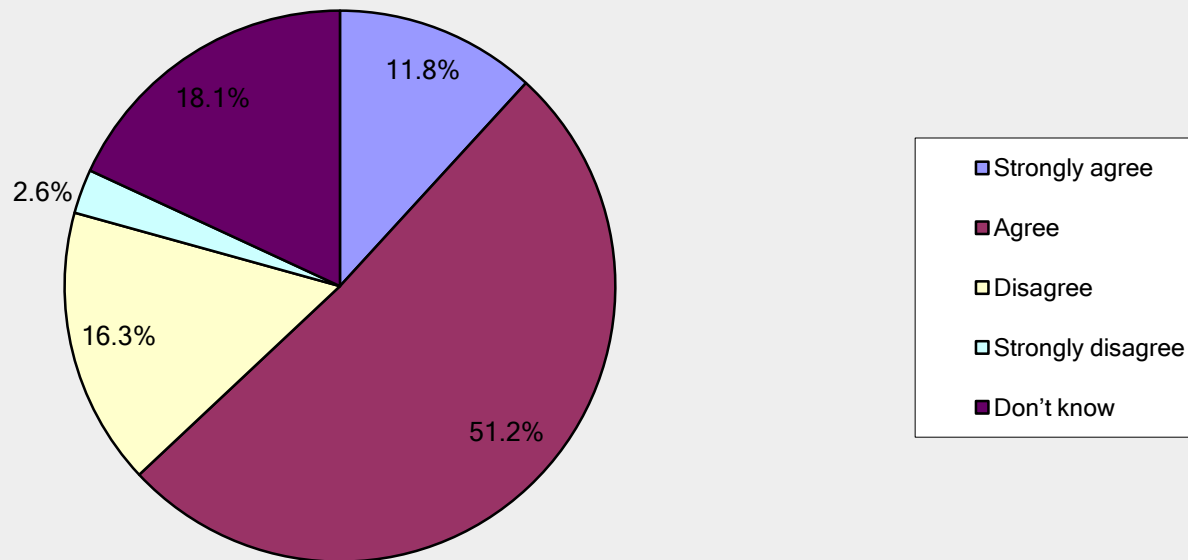

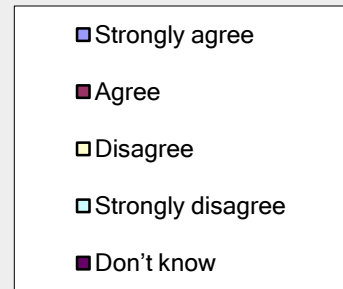
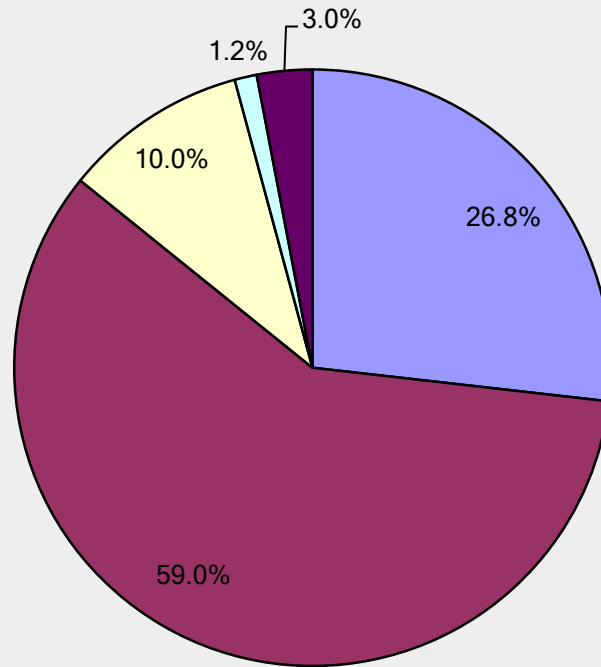


- Overall respondents feel that school communications are timely and clearly communicated.

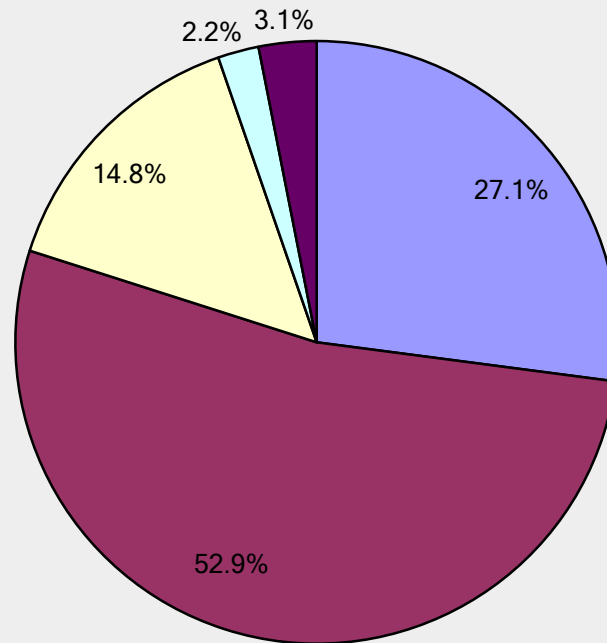

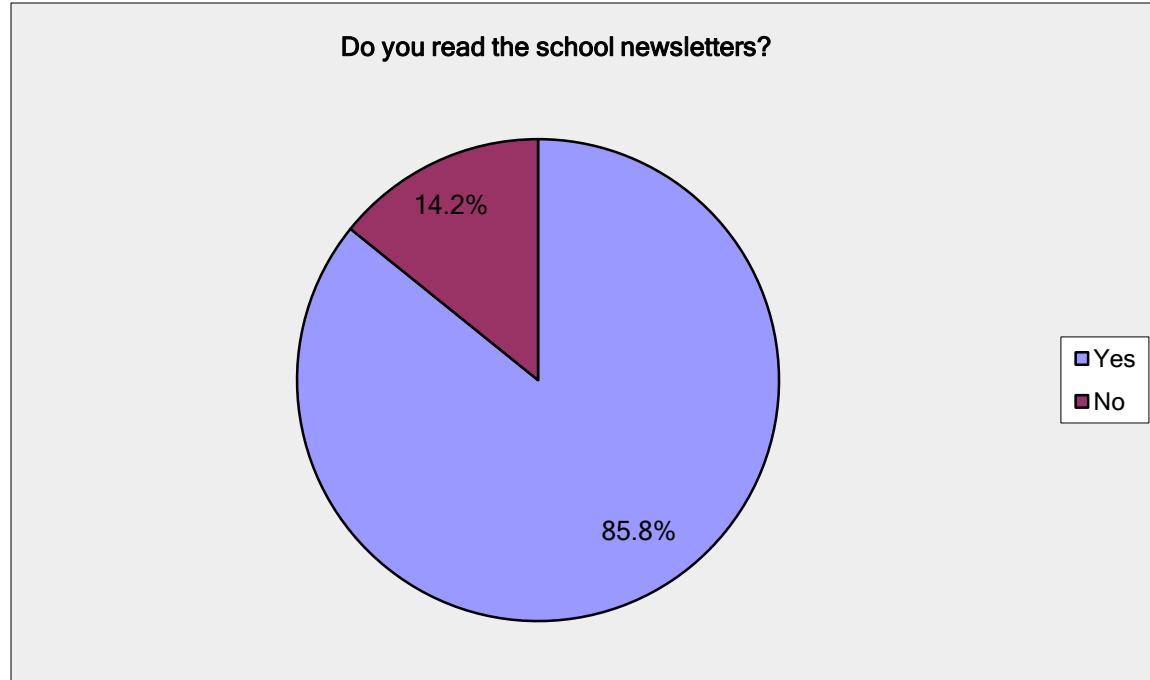
