2016/2017 PARENT SATISFACTION SURVEY RESULTS

Parent Survey Summary

- ➤One thousand and sixteen (1,016) parents responded to the CBE Parent/Guardian Survey.
- The total CBE school enrollment for the 2016-2017 year was two thousand six hundred and seventy-eight (2,678) students. The total enrollment data was used as a guide to estimate the total number of parents.
- ➤One thousand and sixteen (1,016) is a good representative sample of CBE parents.

- ➤In terms of respondent demographics, the majority of CBE parent survey respondents were female, seventy-nine percent (79%).
- There was no difference in responses between male and female respondents.

- >72% of respondents were non- Catholic and 28% were Catholic.
- ➤ Most of the respondents, 55%, have children in grades 1 through 5.
- ➤In terms of the gender of the children of the survey respondents, 54% of respondents have male children and 56% have female children.
- The majority of respondents have children who have attended the school for a period of one to three years.
- None of the aforementioned factors had any impact on the responses of the parent.


- Thirteen percent (13%) of respondents have children who previously graduated from their child's current school.
- Sixty-four percent (64%) of these persons said that their child had been well prepared for the next stage in their life; thirty-five percent (35%) responded that their child had been prepared fairly well.

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
The main reason respondents sent their child/children to a CBE school was overwhelmingly, seventy-six percent (76%) of CBE parents/guardians, because of the academic excellence of the school.






In terms of the survey questions in the Curriculum & Instruction section most respondents agreed with the statements.









ADMINISTRATORS & TEACHERS


Summary

- ➤Sts. Francis & Joseph parents strongly agreed with the statement that teachers provided frequent feedback relative to the academic progress of their child/children.







FACILITIES


Summary

- >St. Francis de Sales parents strongly agreed that the school provided a safe environment and had adequate outdoor space.



SCHOOL VALUES


Summary

- ➤ Parents of St. Francis de Sales strongly agreed that the school provides a Christian atmosphere and sets and maintains standards for Christian behavior.







EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES


Summary

- ➤ Parents of Sts. Francis & Joseph strongly agreed that the school proves sufficient extracurricular and afterschool clubs.





COMMUNICATIONS


Summary

- Sixty-eight percent (68%) of respondents feel that schools can better communicate with them via email.






